

**STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SAP)  
SUMMARY OF SERVICES**

**CLINICAL SERVICES**

- **Confidential Assistance to Students and Family Members with personal, interpersonal, or school performance problems** A free psychiatric evaluation is provided when indicated. Every student and his/her family members can receive up to five or eight (depending upon the company's plan), free, confidential counseling sessions, per type of problem, per year.
- **Assistance with Alcohol and/or Drug Abuse Problems** - All services are provided at one of the three Student Assistance Program offices (Camden, Cherry Hill or Voorhees) with the exception of alcohol and/or drug detoxification and rehabilitation. All drug and alcohol cases are monitored for one year post treatment.
- **Crisis Intervention Services** - There is 24-hour a day access to a mental health professional.
- **Mediation** – Our staff is trained to mediate conflicts arising between two students and causing a school problem.
- **Critical Incident Stress Management services** - Student Assistance Program staff members are trained by the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation and are available to provide critical incident stress management (CISM) services after a student or students experience a traumatic event at the medical school or clinical site.

**EDUCATIONAL SERVICES**

**Student Orientation Sessions** - Student orientations are provided for all students. These thirty-minute sessions help to demystify the program and make asking for help a little easier for all students.

**Student Awareness Material** - Educational materials about the program are provided and include: posters, a letter of introduction, and brochures outlining the program.

**Educational Workshops** - Two workshops are provided per contract year.
