## **Biomedical Science Faculty (BMS) Promotion Calendar**

Updated wording to refer to Rowan University Promotion Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and variance for CMSRU A&P "College" Committee.

## **Description of CMSRU Faculty Pathways and Specific Rank Criteria and Process**

Section 3.4 reworked to delete language regarding designations (academic investigator, clinical investigator, academic educator, and clinician educator) and replaced with pathways to appointment and promotion. Language on alternate pathways deleted. What was previously known as the traditional pathway will now be called the Academic Pathway.

The four pathways to appointment and promotion are:

- Academic (clinicians and tenured/tenure track BMS faculty)
- Scholarship of Practice and Teaching (SPT) Pathway clinicians
- Non-Tenure Teaching Track Professors BMS
- Affiliate Pathway for Allied Health Professionals

General Criteria for Academic Pathway and SPT Pathway updated to add in service to criteria to both pathways. Service includes contributions to university, medical school, hospital and/or wider community or profession.

## Scholarship of Practice and Teaching (SPT) Pathway

Major work done to this section by the A&P Committee working group headed by Andrea Russo, MD.

- Updates to criteria for promotion to next rank in each category.
- For promotion to professor in this pathway candidate must demonstrate <u>excellence</u> in **ALL** domains: clinical service, education, scholarly activity, and service to institution/community.

### **Identified Areas of Special Expertise**

Applicants must show evidence of an area of "special expertise" in clinical practice, education, and teaching, and/or service to the wider medical education or professional community.

Added: Examples of areas of special expertise include but are not limited to: clinical program development, innovative medical treatments/procedures, leadership in medical education/teaching programs at CMSRU/CUHC, high impact community service and leadership within their field and/or medical education, leading or substantive participation in local, regional, national committees related to education, DEI, quality and safety, and health policy.

Examples provided in policy of demonstrated excellence/impact/reputation in clinical practice, examples of demonstrated Educational Excellence/Impact/Reputation and examples of demonstrated Service Excellence/Impact/Reputation in SPT Pathway.

## Non-Tenure Track Teaching Professors - BMS faculty

Formerly known as the Lecturer Track. Ranks are at the Assistant Teaching Professor, Associate Teaching Professor and Teaching Professor level.

#### **Requirements for Letters of Recommendation**

Moved from all individual rank descriptions to become its own section which pertains to all applicants at Assistant Professor level or above.

#### **Clinical Instructor Appointments for Trainees**

Made its own section. Updated language regarding eligibility and timeline for application submissions.
