2023-2024 Highlights of Committee Work

The Faculty Development Committee meets bi-monthly and in academic year 2023-2024 the committee met 5 times. Below are the highlights of the committee's work:

Medical Education Grand Rounds and Faculty Development

The committee works in conjunction with the Dean to program medical education grand rounds. This year's grand rounds and speakers were:

A session on Artificial Intelligence was held through the Faculty Development Forum at CUHC. Sessions on Narrative Writing for ALG facilitators, Antisemitism, Islamophobia, and QPR training for ALG facilitators were offered as part of the Faculty Development Series. In addition, 1 faculty promotion session, 5 CMSRU Medical Education Journal Clubs, and seven BMS Research Seminars were also offered to CMSRU faculty.

Faculty Development Week – March 4, 2024 – March 6, 2024

The committee worked with Dr. Drew Nyce to re-imagine faculty development week with regards to advertising, venues, speakers, didactic session topics, workshops, and delivery of sessions (in-person, hybrid), and development of a participant survey. In addition to programming from the Uniformed Armed Services, the committee also offered programming through Dr. Haney Mallemat's faculty development group.

Didactic session topics were as *follows:* Presentation Design in the 21st Century, Virtual Presentations Don't Suck, You Do, Why Social Media is more than Memes, Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Medical Education, How to Be a Social Media Influencer, and Why every Medical Educator should be One, Rounding/Bedside Teaching in 2024, Feedback for Millennials, Resident Remediation with Case Discussion, Helping Learners Receive and Incorporate Feedback, Coaching Medical students, and Career Planning.

Workshops included: Artificial Intelligence (AI) in Education, Creating a Podcast, Creating Social Media Posts, Creating a Blog, Lo-fidelity Simulation, Feedback Workshop.

A tentative date of March 5, 2025, has been set for Faculty Development Day.

Rowan Marketplace CMSRU Enduring Materials for the Faculty Development Series

A total of 10 new enduring material CME sessions were added to the Rowan Marketplace in 2023-24.
