2023-2024 Highlights of Committee Work

Open Committee Positions 2024

There were 17 open elected faculty positions and 10 open appointed faculty positions this Spring. Positions were open on Academic Standing, Admissions, Appointments & Promotions, Conflict of Interest, Curriculum, Diversity & the Learning Environment, Faculty Development, Library & Informatics, Positive Learning Environment and Rules of Procedure.

26 CMSRU faculty members volunteered to be placed on ballot for committee positions and were vetted by the committee. Election results were finalized in early June and the Dean made her appointee selections immediately following election results. All committee positions are filled for the upcoming 2024-2025 academic year.

Changes to Bylaws

The Dean categorized the curriculum committee, appointments and promotions, and admissions committee to be "Heavy Lifts". CMSRU Bylaws changing to state:

The Curriculum Committee, Advisory Committee on Appointments and Promotions and Admissions Committee are considered time intensive committees, faculty may not serve on more than one of these 3 committees at any given time.

Also, members who have completed a full term on a committee are advised to step off for one to two years to allow for other applicants a chance to serve on that committee.

CMSRU Bylaws changing to state:

After completion of a full 6 year term on a specific committee, the faculty member must step off the committee for at least 2 years prior to serving again on that committee.
