## Accessibility Services Tip Sheet

Students with disabilities who are seeking accommodations from CMSRU, must follow the procedures outlined below, in order to receive accommodations approved under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

### What Accommodations Can I Ask For and What Do I Do?

#### What can I ask for?

- Breaks during exams
- Extended time on exams
- Reduced distraction environment for testing
- Other disability needs

#### What is confidential?

- Meeting discussion
- Diagnosis
- All documentation
- Accommodations are only communicated to specific individuals as necessary

**The Office of Student Affairs is the only entity that can grant accommodations. The need for accommodations should not be discussed with other individuals.**
